Online survey and reporting tool that allows you to quickly creaté online surveys and produce réports.



LABARCHIVES Lab Manual & e-notebook

This is an electronic laboratory notebook. Instructors can upload their lab manual/instructions to the site, and students can record their measurements and observations directly into the e-notebook. The students can also upload photos, videos, Word Documents, PDF files, and other attachments to the enotebook.

Instructors and TAs can see students' work online at any time. They can also submit grades and feedback to the students directly in the notebook. -Rich Goldberg



For the instructor there is a significant time commitment in setting up the lab notebook. Setup time for future semesters is minimal. Students are charged \$10 per class.

This project management & collaboration tool organizes projects into "boards" with "cards" for discrete tasks & activities. The tool allows you to:

Connecting to the classroom computer is supported

consolidate relevant information about a project that may exist in multiple locations (e.g. web, Google Docs, computer files, etc); divide course work into discrete tasks or activities; associate needed support documents with tasks; create checklists of things to be done related to specific tasks; & communicate within the tool about various tasks or parts of the project or class.

I use it for managing the class as a whole. Creating a "project board" for the class with discrete "cards" for various activities (including the ones associated with our class group project) creates a dynamic, interactive space (better than Sakai) for bringing together all of the "parts" related to the class's work (except grades and quizzes). It integrates well with google docs.-Anne Whisnant





Basic version is free. Trello is intuitive, very easy to learn, and offers clear, quick beginner overview tutorials. Instructors may copy one "board" and then work from that one for different classes.
